Executive summary

This document refers to the organization of the project Supervisory Board, Project Management Team and Young Scientist Council according to the management structure and procedures specified in the project, the attributions and responsibilities of these bodies and their roles in accomplishing the objectives of WP2 – Project Management (WP Leader – TUIASI).

Overview on the main objectives of WP2

The main objectives of WP2 are:

- Achieving an efficient and appropriate coordination of the project. The coordinator (**Partner 1 TUIASI**) will be responsible for administrating, organizing and monitoring the adequate functioning of the technical, administrative and financial components of the project. The coordinator will maintain the respective Commission services informed concerning all project's developments
- Setting-up the communication structures for a coherent and efficient collaboration within the consortium (web-based reporting tool and intranet)

The Supervisory Board – structure, attributions and responsibilities

The Supervisory Board of the project comprises all Team Leaders and is chaired by the Project Coordinator. The Supervisory Board was nominated in the BrainTwin Kick-off Meeting, on 24th September 2020 and confirmed in the 1st Steering Committee Meeting, on 21st October 2020.

The Supervisory Board:

- Actively participates in all the communication activities related to the BrainTwin project.
- Has the overall responsibility for the Consortium
- Makes decisions on all aspects of the project, both strategic and tactical
- Coordinates educational activities, knowledge transfer, management, communication and dissemination activities
- Monitors and controls the project progress and quality, assess risks, legal, ethical, financial and administrative activities related to the project execution.

- Makes, via its Coordinator, regular reports to the European Commission and Participants Approves financial reports
- Sets up the dates and agenda for the Operational Boards meetings and the Consortium workshops.

The decision making process is based on the consensus between the Participants.

The Supervisory Board meets online once a month or whenever necessary to discuss day-to-day problems.
